Our guests make their way to Torres del Paine from all over the world. As humans have understood for centuries, the call of the wild is strong. Nowadays, for those of us who live in large cities, the call is particularly hard to ignore.

"Not only are we used to living with air pollution, but also with constant noise pollution. But here you can feel the wind, listen to the birds. It's priceless." (Paz Buscuñan)

For Chilean actors Paz Bascuñan and Luis Gnecco, Santiago is base camp, a city which - as with most capitals - is not conducive to sustained reflection, slow living, or contemplation of nature.
